From Capitol Beltway, take I-66 west 21.7 miles to Exit 43A (US-29 South Gainesville/Warrenton). Take US-29 South for 11.5 miles to intersection for US-29 Business. Stay straight on US-29 marked Culpeper/Frederickburg 1 mile to Meetze Road exit (Rte. 643). Turn Right on Meetze Road. Go straight at stop sign and the road becomes East Lee Street. Parking available in the municipal lots off Lee Street.

Directions from South

From Culpeper take US-29 North to Warrenton. Take second Warrenton exit (Meetze Road/Rte. 643). Turn Left on Meetze Road. Go straight at stop sign and the road becomes East Lee Street. Parking available in the municipal lots off Lee Street.

Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement

In consideration of being permitted to participate in any Fauquier Trails Coalition, Inc., Warrenton Cycling, or Fauquier County Parks and Recreation Department sponsored bicycling event, I, for myself and my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin:

1. I acknowledge that this athletic event is an extreme test of a person's physical and mental limits and carries with it the potential for death, serious injury and property loss. The risks include, but are not limited to, those caused by terrain, facilities, temperature, weather, condition of athletes, equipment, vehicular traffic, actions of other people including, but not limited to, participants, volunteers, spectators, coaches, event officials, and event monitors, and/or producers of the event, and lack of hydration. These risks are not only inherent to athletics, but are also present for volunteers. I hereby assume all of the risks of participating &/or volunteering in this event. I realize that liability may arise from negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities being released, from dangerous or defective equipment or property owned, maintained or controlled by them or because of their possible liability without fault.

2. I certify that I am physically fit, have sufficiently trained for participation in the event and have not been advised otherwise by a qualified medical person. I acknowledge that this Accident Waiver and Release of Liability (AWRL) form will be used by the event holders, sponsors, and organizers in events in which I may participate and that it will govern my actions and responsibilities at said events.

3. In consideration of my application and permitting me to participate in this event, I hereby take action for myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assign as follows: (A)Waive, Release and Discharge from any and all liability for my death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft or actions of any kind which may hereafter accrue to me or my traveling to and from this event, Warrenton Cycling and The Fauquier Trails Coalition, its officers and members, and their directors, officers, employees, volunteers, representatives, and agents, the event holders, event sponsors, event directors, event volunteers, and event officials (collectively Releasees);(B)Indemnify and Hold Harmless the entities for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, assignees and successors in interest (collectively Successors) I HEREBY WAIVE, RELEASE, DISCHARGE, HOLD HARMLESS AND PROMISE TO INDEMNIFY AND NOT TO SUE the releasees and the sponsors of this event, the organizer and any promoting organizations, property owners, law enforcement agencies, all public entities, special districts and properties, and their respective agents, officials, and employees through or by which the events will be held, (the foregoing are also collectively deemed to be releasees) FROM ANY and all rights and CLAIMS INCLUDING CLAIMS ARISING FROM THE RELEASEE 'S OWN NEGLIGENCE which I have or which may hereafter accrue to me and from any and all damages which may be sustained by me directly or indirectly in connection with, or arising out of my participation in or association with the event or travel to or return from the event.

I hereby consent to receive medical treatment, which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident and/or illness during this event. I am aware that this event is not an event permitted by USA Cycling and that USA Cycling insurance does not apply. I understand that at this event or related activities I may be photographed. I agree to allow my photo, video or film likeness to be used for any legitimate purpose by the event holders, producers, sponsors, organizers and/or assigns. This AWRL shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law. I hereby certify that I have read this document and I understand its content.
